



HAITI ARISE TECHNICAL SCHOOL: PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Canadian Collision Industry Forum (CCIF) provides a national venue for all collision industry stakeholders – collision repairers, suppliers, insurers, associations, OEs, and educators – to network, share information, and collaborate to develop solutions to common industry issues and challenges. Managed by the Automotive Industries Association, of Canada, CCIF has committed to make a difference in the development of the Haiti Arise technical school in Grand Goave, Haiti.

WHAT WE'VE DONE:

2014

CCIF partnered with the Haiti Arise organization in 2014 with the objective to build a collision repair training and production facility in Grand Goave, Haiti.

CCIF reached out to our US equivalent organization, CIC, and they are partnering with us on this project. Our goal is to create a long-term sustainable collision repair educational program to improve the lives of thousands of Haitian families and create positive change in the community and country.

CCIF volunteers traveled to Grand Goave to meet with Haiti Arise founders and to validate the opportunity to achieve our goal 2012

In 2015, we established a "BUY-A-BRICK" campaign, and through individual donations we have accumulated \$30,000 in cash donations.

We also have collected supplies and equipment, and have commitments for donations of much more. In September, the CCIF team met with the leadership group of the Calgary based Haiti Arise organization.

The focus was to gain more specific information regarding the size of the investment needed along with developing a time line for the project.

OUR 2016 OBJECTIVE

We believe it is critical to be in a position to execute the plan in 2017. To accomplish this, we need to expand our reach in sourcing the funds to complete the construction. Our minimum goal is to raise \$200,000 this year. This is the amount required to complete the construction and to be able to ship the acquired equipment and supplies to Haiti.

We are asking all Canadian collision repair industry corporate stakeholders to consider contributing to this project to reach our objective. Your organization has been active as an ongoing sponsor and financial supporter of CCIF. We have all benefited greatly from having access to the information and networking opportunities that CCIF has provided. 


HISTORY & BACKGROUND

Haiti ARISE Ministries was founded in 2000 by Marc Honorat. Marc was a slave child in Haiti who was rescued by a Canadian family from Calgary. After completing his education and marrying in Canada, he returned to Haiti to meet the need for change in his homeland. The Haiti Arise head office remains in Calgary, and the campus sits on 4.8 acres in Grand-Goave, in the southwest of the island of Haiti. The organization is actively working to bring change in the nation through education and training. By providing a place to stimulate hope in the lives of the community members, the people will in turn be able to make changes in their own lives and communities.

The original school facility had just been completed before the January 12, 2010 earthquake, which severely damaged it beyond repair. The school had to be demolished just one month after its completion and after 7 years of construction. Since the disaster, the technical school has been re-built and expanded, a primary school and medical clinic now operate to serve the community of over 415,000 people, and construction of a children's village to rescue slave children is nearing completion.
